

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the registration cost/activity fee cover?

Registration and activity fee that is paid upon registration covers all of the registration fees, game uniform (pants and jersey), a t-shirt, special events and things coordinated by the team mom during the season, end of the year banquet, gift and trophy, as well as coaches gifts.

What else will I need to buy for the season?

You will need to provide your player football cleats, a white helmet, pads (shoulder, leg and hip pads), a mouthpiece, practice jersey and pants. There is also a small charge for lettering on the jerseys.

Is the football camp on July 24th mandatory and how do I register?

Football camp is July 24-27 and it is a Parkview run camp. It is not mandatory for Mtn. Park players, however, it is recommended. Many skills and fundamentals are taught by the Parkview coaches and the players do benefit a great deal from the camp. What if my player cannot be at uniform fittings on July 15th?

You can take your player to Colter's Sporting Goods on Five Forks Trickum Rd. at Oak Rd. to be fitted prior to the scheduled fitting date. They will register his/her name, size, and jersey number.

How do I request a specific jersey number?

If your child played at Mtn. Park last year, you can request to have the same jersey number. If this is his/her first year, you can request your top three choices.

How much are physicals and do I have to have the physical done at Parkview on the 20th?

Physicals at Parkview High School are \$10, however, you can have a physical completed by a physician of your choice. If you do not have this done at Parkview, you will need to provide an original physical, less than a year old, signed by a MD or DO.

What is the deadline for physicals?

The GFL rule states that no player can participate in practice of any kind, including try-outs on the 24th, without presenting MPAA with a current physical.

What are try-outs for and do we have to be at try-outs on the 24th and 25th?

Try-outs are to help the coaches determine a player's level of experience, speed, etc. to assist in the draft. If your player is not at try-outs, they are to be considered a "hat pick" in the draft, even if they are a returning player.

When will we know who our coach is?

The draft will take place on July 29th. Your coach or team mom will call you after the draft for further instructions.

What is the practice schedule like?

The first two weeks of practice (July 31 thru Aug. 4, and Aug. 7 thru Aug. 11) are Monday thru Friday, 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Once school begins (Aug. 14), practices are cut back to Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, 6:30 to 8:00 p.m.
